Miguel Calatayud is the CEO of iwi, a disruptive and sustainable algaebased nutrition company that produces plant-based protein and plantbased EPA-Omega3, using only non-arable land and saltwater while creating jobs in rural communities. "Together we create sustainable food solutions for everyone and our planet".

Before iwi, Calatayud co-founded Blencor, LLC, a disruptive frozen food company with the latest technologies for blending enrobing and packing frozen vegetables, fruits, smoothies and complete meals. Previous to that, he served as the COO of Ultracongelados Virto S.A., a leading frozen food company which he helped scale and take global. He oversaw the growing, processing, sales and distribution of over 700 million pounds of vegetables per year across 5 continents.

Calatayud serves as Board Member of the Houston Food Bank, the biggest food bank in the world, as Board Member of the Spain-US Chamber of Commerce, as Board Member of GOED (Global Organization for EPA and DHA Omega-3s) and as Director- Board Member in several industry related, and nonprofit organizations.

Calatayud has been invited as a lecturer at the NASA Innovation Summit, United Nations-FAO, Abu Dhabi Sustainability Week, Conscious Capitalism Summit, YPO World Innovation Summit and Near Future Summit, among others.
