Gonzalo is the Director of the Energy and Climate Change Program at the Elcano Royal Institute and a full professor of Economic Policy in the Department of Applied Economics at the Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia (UNED).

He holds a PhD in Business and Economics from the Universidad Complutense de Madrid, and has been a Visiting Researcher at Florida State University and the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, and an Associate Researcher at the Ortega y Gasset Foundation's Spanish Center for International Relations.

He regularly teaches on the subjects of energy geopolitics and North African economic policy in the graduate programs of a number of universities in Spain and the rest of the world. He has participated in different Spanish and international research projects, including EU Framework Program 7 and several of the European Commission's FEMISE Euro-Mediterranean projects. He received a research award from the Economic and Social Council.
